Introductory and training series tests are from the NZ Pony Club Blue Book – Riding Tests 2001 – available from the Tielcey Park Tack Room Online Store (www.tielceypark.co.nz). Also available on the site is the NZEF Dressage Test book.*

FEES - Entry Fees: Lead-Rein–\$4/test; Introductory –\$4/test; Lead-Rein - \$4/test; Training: \$5/test; Level 1 - \$6/test; Level 2 - \$7/test; Level 3 - \$8/test; **First Year Rider, Child Rider and Junior Rider Series Fees:** \$10/rider per series (pay once); **Ground Levy** - \$15/horse/day – Tielcey Park Club Members \$10/horse/day; **Accommodation** - Day yards \$5/day, Overnight yards: \$10/night and day, Exceptional stabling \$20/night (please state nights required on entry form); camping/overnighting in your truck or float - \$5 per person to a maximum of \$15/truck/float/tent.

PRACTICE DAY: Dressage arenas available for practice - **\$10/horse for the day**, starts 9am - pay on the day, no need to book. **“Feedback Judges” available on practice days** – ride your test in front of a judge who discuss your test sheet with you and how you can improve your marks for show day – no charge - to book email margo@tielceypark.co.nz or phone 06 353 3533

CONDITIONS:

- This series is run under Tielcey Park Rules and these will be enforced.** Tielcey Park Rules are the same as NZEF rules except in some circumstances: for example: bitless bridles and hoof boots (including those coming above the coronet band) are allowed under Tielcey Park Rules – check with us to see what else is allowed.
- Support Our Sponsor:** Please support Farmlands – without them we would have no shows at Tielcey Park.
- Alterations:** Tielcey Park reserves the right to alter or cancel the programme if necessary.
- Number of classes per day:** Horses and ponies may compete in more than one grade each day but must nominate Series. No restriction on the number of tests entered per day. **Ribbons** to 6th place in all classes.
- Late Entries** – Entries close strictly on closing date. Late entries may be allowed, however if accepted, late entries incur a 50% additional charge on class fees. Please phone the office 06 353 3533 to enquire about late entries.
- Series points** will be awarded to the first ten horses in each class, 10 points for 1st, 9 points for 2nd etc. Double points will be awarded at the September show. Competitors must attend the September show to be eligible for the championship but do not need to bring their horse if they are certain of their position. All series champions and reserve champions will receive a sash.
- Introductory Tests** - walk and trot only, open to riders beginning dressage – lead-rein riders separate class.
- First Year Rider Series** – is open to riders in their first year of entering dressage competitions – no age limit. Entry fee to be paid once for series and noted on each entry form. Points accumulate from all classes and all ponies/horses ridden throughout series.
- Child Rider Series** – is open to riders 14 years and under as of 31 December 2008. Entry fee to be paid once for series and noted on each entry form. Points accumulate from all classes and all ponies/horses ridden throughout series.
- Junior Rider Series** – is open to riders 15 years to 21 years as of 31 December 2008. Entry fee to be paid once for series and noted on each entry form. Points accumulate from all classes and all horses ridden throughout series.
- Parking** - To ensure all vehicles can park on grounds and for the safety of competitors and their horses, we do not allow horses and ponies to be tied to trucks or floats in certain allocated parking areas, see our website for details – book stable or yard accordingly. All parking is allocated; note on entry form the size of your truck/float-car and license plate. No cars allowed in truck and float parking areas. **Note on entry form Tielcey Park Club member number.**
- Tielcey Park Club** - Parking and stabling will be allocated firstly to Tielcey Park Club members, and then by date of entry receipt. Note club membership number on entry form, or join the Tielcey Park Club on our website www.tielceypark.co.nz or phone us for a membership application form, 06 353 3533.
- Programme** - Check our website www.tielceypark.co.nz from the Wednesday before the show for the draw; enclose SSAE if no internet access.
- Scratchings:** Refund of 75% of entry fee if confirmed in writing accompanied by doctor and/or veterinary certificate within one week after event, or we can carry forward 75% of your entry fee to the next show.
