**TEST BOOKS:** Lead-Rein, Introductory and Training series tests are from the NZ Pony Club Blue Book – Riding Tests 2001- available from Tielcey Park. Also available is the ESNZ Dressage Test book.

**FEES – Entry Fees:** Lead-Rein \$6/test; Introductory \$6/test; Training \$7/test; Level 1 \$8/test; Level 2 \$8/test; Level 4 \$9/test; **First Year Rider, Child Rider and Junior Rider Series Fees:** \$10/rider per series (pay once and state on form); **Show Levy** - \$15/horse/day  
**Accommodation** - Day yards \$5/day; Overnight yards \$10/night and day, Exceptional stabling \$20/night and day (please state nights required on entry form); camping/overnighting in your truck or float - \$5/person/night to a maximum of \$15/truck/float/tent.

#### PRACTICE DAYS

\$10/horse for use of dressage arenas (including indoor arena); starts 9am the day before each show - pay on the day, no need to book.

## CONDITIONS

- This series is run under Tielcey Park Rules and these will be enforced.** Tielcey Park Rules are the same as ESNZ rules except in some circumstances: for example – Pelham bits, bitless bridles and hoof boots (including those coming above the coronet band), and chaps made of suede are all allowed under Tielcey Park Rules – check with us to see what else is allowed.
- Alterations:** Tielcey Park reserves the right to alter or cancel the programme if necessary. Riders ride at their own risk. Tielcey Park takes no responsibility for any accidents. The event manager has the authority to evict and eliminate anyone whom they deem to be acting in an unacceptable manner. Any bounced or stopped cheques will incur a \$20 admin fee.
- Late Entries** – entries close strictly on closing date. Late entries may be accepted and will incur a \$5 late fee per horse. Please phone 021 741 772 to enquire about late entries.
- Championships: Championship Sashes will be awarded to the Champion and Reserve Champion for each series.** Series points will be awarded to the first ten placings in each class, 10 points for 1<sup>st</sup>, 9 points for 2<sup>nd</sup> etc. **Double points** will be awarded at the last show. Series points allocated for each class. Competitors may enter multiple series and classes at each show, but must nominate at each show only one horse to gain points for rider series at each show. Competitors must attend the final show to be eligible for championship sashes but do not need to bring their horse if they are certain of their position. Please advise the secretary if you are attending final show without your horse to ensure placings are accurate.
- Introductory Tests** - walk and trot only – lead-rein riders separate class.
- Lead-Rein Riders** may not enter any other class at show on any horse/pony.
- First Year Rider Series** – is open to riders in their first year of entering dressage competitions – no age limit. Entry fee to be paid once for series and noted on each entry form. Points accumulate from one nominated horse ridden each day.
- Child Rider Series** – is open to riders 14 years and under as of date of each show. Entry fee to be paid once for series and noted on each entry form. Points accumulate from one nominated horse ridden each day.
- Junior Rider Series** – is open to riders 15 years to 21 years as of date of each show. Entry fee to be paid once for series and noted on each entry form. Points accumulate from one nominated horse ridden each day.
- Parking** - To ensure everybody can park on the grounds, **all parking will be allocated.** Ensure you state whether you have a truck or float & car, date arriving on the entry form. . To ensure all vehicles are able to park on the grounds and for the safety of competitors and spectators, **we have limited parking areas where horses and ponies are allowed to be kept at trucks or floats.** Ensure you book a yard or stable or request a tie-up parking space.
- Scratchings:** Must be phoned to the secretary before or on show day – and then confirmed in writing accompanied by doctor/farrier/veterinary certificate within one week after event. We can either carry forward 75% of your entry fee and 100% of show levies and accommodation fees to the next show or refund to your bank account.

- Entries on official entry form only with all fees.** Entries without fees will be returned.
