This show is part of the Summer 2010-11 Show Jumping & Combined Training Series.

- **Open to registered and unregistered horses and ponies**
- **Show jumping entries accepted on the day without penalty**, but Combined Training entries must be received by closing date or pay a \$5 late fee. All classes instant jump off.
- **Show jumping ring open from 8am for practice rounds** (free with payment of show levy). **60cm class starts 9am sharp**. All other classes follow.
- **Practice jumps** indoors until dressage finishes – then outdoors as well.
- **Practice Day Saturday 12<sup>th</sup> March – \$10/horse** includes use of a yard - indoor arena unavailable.

**FEES**

**Show jumping:** 60cm–80cm: \$7/Class; 90cm – 1m05: \$8/class; 1m10 – 1m20: \$9/class

**Combined Training:** Introductory & Pre-training \$14/class; Training & Pre-Novice \$16/class; Novice \$18/class

**Show Levy** - \$15/day/horse; **Day yards** \$5/day; **Overnight yards** \$10/night ; **Exceptional stabling** \$20/night (please state nights required on entry form)

**CONDITIONS**

1. **This series is run under Tielcey Park Rules and these will be enforced.** Tielcey Park Rules are the same as ESNZ rules except in some circumstances: for example in the dressage phase – Pelham bits, bitless bridles and hoof boots (including those coming above the coronet band) are all allowed under Tielcey Park Rules – check with us to see what else is allowed.
2. **Alterations:** Tielcey Park reserves the right to alter or cancel the programme if necessary. Riders ride at their own risk. Tielcey Park takes no responsibility for any accidents. The event manager has the authority to evict and eliminate anyone whom they deem to be acting in an unacceptable manner. Any bounced or stopped cheques will incur a \$20 admin fee.
3. **Championships: Championship Sashes will be awarded to the Champion and Reserve Champion for each grade in showjumping and each class in combined training.** Series points will be awarded to the first six placings in each class, 10 points for 1<sup>st</sup>, 9 points for 2<sup>nd</sup> etc. Double points will be awarded at the September show. Series points allocated for each class. Competitors may enter multiple series and classes at each show, but must nominate at each show only one combined training grade for championship points. Competitors must attend the March show to be eligible for championship sashes but do not need to bring their horse if they are certain of their position.
4. **Parking** - To ensure everybody can park on the grounds, **all parking will be allocated.** Ensure you state whether you have a truck or float & car, date arriving on the entry form. . To ensure all vehicles are able to park on the grounds and for the safety of competitors and spectators, **we have limited parking areas where horses and ponies are allowed to be kept at trucks or floats.** Ensure you book a yard or stable or request a tie-up park.
5. **Scratchings:** Must be phoned to the secretary before or on show day – and then confirmed in writing accompanied by doctor/farrier/veterinary certificate within one week after event. We can either carry forward your entry fee less show levy to our next show or refund to your bank account.
6. **Please check our website** [www.tielceypark.co.nz](http://www.tielceypark.co.nz) from the Thurs before the show for draw and parking allocations; enclose SSAE if no access.
7. **Entries on official entry form only with all fees.** Entries without fees will be returned.
